## God Wills the Salvation of Everyone

Jesus had a specific mission to accomplish during his earthly lifetime. He was to fulfil the Old Testament prophecies and lay the foundation for the universal sacrament of salvation, the Catholic Church. And he stayed focused on that mission! Jesus never travelled to exotic locations like Rome and Spain, never visited the intellectual powerhouses of Athens and Alexandria. Those countries and the rest of the world outside Palestine would receive God's truth and grace not from him directly, but later, through his body, the Church. And yet, when the Canaanite woman approaches him and, by her faith, humility, and persistence, moves his heart, he changes his plans. In so doing, he gives us a brilliant glimpse into the reason behind everything he does: the salvation of souls. Jesus came "to undo the work of the devil" (1 John 3:8), which had brought the human family into its sinful, fallen state. As St Paul put it in his First Letter to Timothy, God wants "everyone to be saved and reach the full knowledge of the truth" (1 Timothy 2:4). And as he puts it in today's Second Reading: "For God delivered all to disobedience," [in other words, he permitted sin and evil to spread throughout the entire human family], "that he might have mercy upon all. This was one of the most revolutionary aspects of the Gospel. In Old Testament times, salvation from sin, both original and personal, had been reserved only to the Jews, only to the one Chosen People. But with the coming of Jesus, all peoples, all the Gentile nations are now invited to hope for eternal life in the household of God, the "house of prayer for all peoples" as Isaiah had prophesied in the First Reading.

Paying Cash in now is now done through the Post Office Counters for which we are charged by the Bank. The charges are steadily increasing (averaging £120 per month) and we would like to avoid your donation lining the pockets of the International Banking systems and Bankers' profits.

All your donations go to the work and supporting of the Church. Thanks to the NHS and the number of funerals the priests are doing, they are completely self-funded!!

Please be aware that if you are eligible for Gift-Aid, you only need to enter your details in the contactless terminals <u>once</u>, thereafter they will be remembered and applied every time you donate using the same card.

Similarly, if you're in a rush, you can enter your Gift-Aid details in the terminals or via the parish website at any time and any previous donations will have the Gift-Aid applied.

#### GIFT AID 2022/23

As a result of this year's claims for Our Lady Queen of Peace, we will receive £26934 (£26076 for 2021/22). In addition, we will also receive £2715 for Small Plate collections. The Diocese has provided individual letters for each parishioner who had a current Gift Aid Declaration for the tax year 2022/23. These confirm the amount given together with the amount of tax that we have been able to claim back. The letters also provide information for the ever-increasing number of those who pay tax at the higher rate and can claim additional valuable personal relief through their tax returns. These letters are now available for collection at the back of Annunciation (rear door) or will be posted out to individuals at Holy Family and Holy Spirit.

# Please note for Annunciation that the addresses shown may not have been updated from the date the original declaration was signed.

Could we please ask that everyone in the scheme to collect their envelope and check their details. To join the scheme, you need to pay by standing order, offertory box (both of which can also be provided upon request) or via the contactless machines in Annunciation.
