OUR MISSION IS TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE FOR OTHERS

Jesus chose his words carefully - including the words we just listened to. They are part of his famous Sermon on the Mount, which is like a highlight film of all his sermons. In this section, he is explaining to his followers what he expects of them. It is like a coach talking to his players before the big game - but this is Jesus talking to us about the game of life itself. It is like a general instructing his troops before a big battle - but this is Jesus talking to us about the battle of life. He is giving us our life-mission.....And what is that life-mission? To be salt and light for the world around us. Salt had two functions in the ancient world: it gave flavour to food, and it also preserved food. They didn't have refrigerators back then, so they would preserve meat by putting a thin layer of salt over it. Light had the same function then as it does now: to push back the darkness. But in the ancient world, before the advent of electricity, darkness was a much more dramatic reality than it is to us. The ancients understood how helpless they were without a lamp. We, on the other hand, because electric lighting is everywhere, rarely even have to think about our need for light. Salt and light - these are the comparisons Jesus uses to explain our life-mission. And what is the common characteristic of salt and light? They are both for something else. Their purpose is not self-centred, but other-cantered. And that's the point. A Christian's mission in the world, just like Christ's mission, is to make a positive difference for others, by bringing them the power and the illumination of the Gospel.

THE ANNUNCIATION CHURCH IS NOW CONTACTLESS

Parishioners attending <u>Sunday</u> Masses at the Church of the Annunciation now have the option of making an offering via contactless payment. Initially this will be for weekly offertory donations but an option screen will be available as necessary to also allow donations for Easter, Christmas, Special Collection, Flowers etc.

Secure payment terminals are situated at the rear of the church and parishioners can opt for any amount of their choosing before simply tapping their card or mobile device. In addition, a donation portal is available on the website through which anybody may make a one-off donation.

When using the new payment terminals, after selecting a donation value an option button will show on screen Gift Aid YES/NO. If you are a tax payer and wish payments to be gift aided, the YES button will then invite you to complete basic details of Name/House number/Postcode/Email.

These should be completed EVEN IF YOU ARE ALREADY A GIFT AIDER. This is a one-off exercise and all future payments will generate Gift Aid for the Parish but you must continue to use the same payment card.

If you are unable to complete the Gift Aid information when first using the terminal, subsequent completion via the terminal or via our website (parishofourladyqueenofpeace.org)
