By using the envelopes, you do not commit to giving a set amount each week.

If you pay tax and have not completed a Gift Aid form then these are also available from the contacts below. It costs nothing, only one simple form needs completing which covers all future years, and the Parish gains an extra 25p for every £1 that you give under the envelope scheme or by bank standing order payments.

Gift Aid is a very important source of funds, providing income of £29000 last year. Yellow envelopes will also be available at the back of our Churches for Easter Offerings. These can be used for BOTH gift aid and non gift aid offerings – you only need to print your name on the envelope.
